

CCQG 2020 quilt challenge

WHO: All CCQG members

WHAT: Make a challenge quilt. All quilts will be displayed in a special exhibit at our next quilt show on July 18, 2020.

WHEN: All challenge quilts will be turned in at the May 2020 meeting.

WHY: Challenge yourself! Run with your creativity and imagination within a few guidelines. When all the quilts are displayed together you will see how fun and interesting it is to see how differently each participant interpreted the challenge.

And just for fun, we'll ask viewers to vote for their favorite challenge quilt and award first, second, and third place.

GUIDELINES :

1. Finished quilts must be 24" x 24"
2. At least ONE Summer Winds block must appear in the quilt top, any size or amount. Your quilt may be hand or machine pieced, appliquéd, fused, woven, any technique or combination of techniques.
3. To commemorate 30 years of CCQG, some RED must appear in the quilt top (pink to deep burgundy, like cranberries); the amount of red is your choice.
4. Quilts must have finished edges and have three layers, top, filler, and back. It must be quilted: hand, big stitch, free motion quilting, long arm, embroidered, cross stitched, sashiko, boro, etc. and/or any combination of stitching.
5. Have an attached label on the back: maker's name, date, location, quilt name optional.

SUMMER WINDS BLOCK

This block is on p. 245 in the "501 Rotary Cut Quilt Blocks" book by Judy Hopkins.

Summer Winds block is very versatile. Color choice, value, and placement can make it traditional to contemporary. Remember, this is your challenge. This page is the suggestion of the author and meant only to provide block sizes and assembly.

These four blocks below are all the Summer Wind blocks! Color choices, placement, value, contrast will make your block (or blocks) unique.

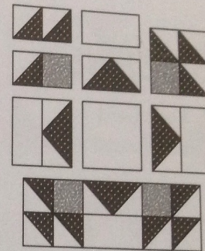
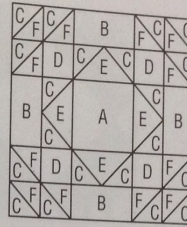
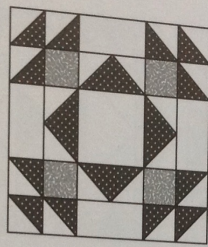
These four are all the same Summer Wind block!

FINISHED BLOCK SIZE

Single dimensions in the cutting chart indicate the size of the cut square (3" = 3" x 3").

FOR 1 BLOCK:

		4½"	6"	7½"	9"	10½"	12"
Light	A: 1 □	2"	2½"	3"	3½"	4"	4½"
	B: 4 □	1¼" x 2"	1½" x 2 ½"	1¾" x 3"	2" x 3½"	2¼" x 4"	2½" x 4½"
	C: 10 □ → □	1⅝"	1⅞"	2⅛"	2⅜"	2⅝"	2⅞"
Medium	D: 4 □	1¼"	1½"	1¾"	2"	2¼"	2½"
Dark	E: 1 □ → □	2¾"	3¼"	3¾"	4¼"	4¾"	5¼"
	F: 6 □ → □	1⅝"	1⅞"	2⅛"	2⅜"	2⅝"	2⅞"

Try this: Use one light for A and B and a different light for C.
