**PROCEDURES FOR CHARITY QUILT DONATION**

DONATION QUILT, QUILTED, BOUND, AND READY TO DONATE:

- Obtain an Information Card from Joyce Owens
- Complete the card and attach it to the quilt with a safety pin
- Return it to Joyce, who will tag it, log it in, and oversee the donation to charity

DONATION QUILT TOP IN NEED OF QUILTING BY THE GALLOS:

- The quilt top submitted to the guild will be quilted & bound by Lou & Evette Gallo. You supply the **backing, which must be 6" wider and 6" longer** than the entire quilt. WITHOUT THIS, it cannot be quilted by Lou. (They will cut the guild's batting for your quilt top.)
- A 2½" binding that is cut, sewn together, folded in half, and pressed must also be included, as Evette will be machine stitching it to the quilt. Include the adequate length of binding in a separate plastic bag.
- Fill out the Information Card (from Gallo or Owens), and attach it to the quilt with a safety pin. Give the quilt, backing, and binding to the Gallos.
- Upon completion by the Gallos, the quilt will be given to Joyce who will tag it, log it in, and oversee the donation to charity.

REQUEST FOR BATTING TO BE USED FOR CHARITY QUILTS:

- Guild batting for charity quilts is stored by Lou and Evette Gallo. Make requests to them, in writing, including the size of the piece(s) needed.
- They will cut the batting requested and set it on the pool table for pickup at the next monthly meeting. Joyce Owens will be notified of the request for charity quilt batting.
- If the batting is needed prior to the next guild meeting, arrangements can be made to pick up at the Gallo's home.
